**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S
AMENDED MOTION TO APPROVE DISTRIBUTION PLAN**

On this day, the Court considered the Receiver's Amended Motion to Approve Distribution Plan (the "***Motion***")¹.

The Court, having considered the Motion and the information submitted in support, responses or objections, if any, the arguments of counsel, and the pleadings on file finds that the Motion should be, and hereby is, GRANTED

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The Motion is GRANTED in its entirety.
2. The Court finds the distribution plan set forth in the Motion (the "***Plan***") is fair and reasonable, and is approved, including without limitation:
 - a. The classification of claims as described in Section II(F) (Classes of Claims) in the Motion;
 - b. The method of distribution, including approval of a rising tide distribution methodology for Class 3 Claimants. Consistent with the rising tide method

of distribution, any reinvested dividends in the Fund should be ignored for the purposes of determining distributions;

c. The process for making distributions detailed in Section III (D) of the Plan;

3. The Receiver is authorized, but not required, to make distributions to Class 1 and Class 2 Claimants immediately. The Receiver is authorized, but not required, to make distributions to Class 3 Claimants upon payment in full of Class 1 and Class 2 Claimants.

4. To be eligible for the distribution payment, each allowed Claimant must provide the Receiver with a completed and signed W-9 on the most recent form W-9, found at <https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/fw9.pdf> pursuant to procedures to be promulgated by the Receiver in coordination with his claims agent, Stretto. The allowed Claimant shall have 90 days from the date the distribution check is issued to negotiate the payment. To the extent the distribution payment is not negotiated within 90 days from the date of the check, such check shall be canceled, and the underlying funds will remain to the Receivership Estate for distribution to other allowed Claimants in this case pursuant to the priority established by the Plan or as otherwise ordered by this Court.
